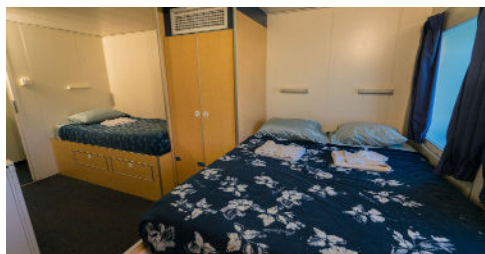
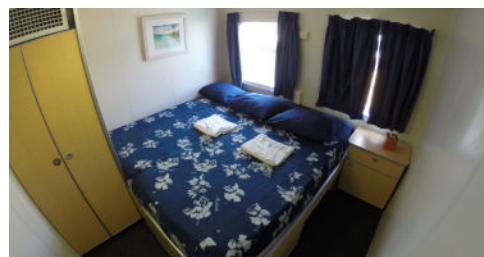

The Bahamas are one of the most popular dive destinations for North American divers due to the ease of access and exceptional diving. Departing on Saturdays, the Aqua Cat travels from Nassau to the Exuma Cays, a dive location frequented only by liveaboards. As such, these dive sites are more preserved and pristine. Divers can explore reefs, wrecks, blue hole, walls, discover swift water dives, corals and sponges and swim with sharks. A popular passive shark feed is also offered. A highlight of the cruise is visiting the protected Exuma Cays Land & Sea Park.

The Aqua Cat provides a luxurious 7-night liveaboard dive experience where you can log up to 26 dives, including night dives and still have ample time for snorkeling, kayaking and sunbathing. Our tri-level liveaboard is staffed with a professional crew of 10 and features full board, chef-prepared meals and beverages, 10 spacious cabins with ocean-view windows and 1 skylight cabin, all with private bathrooms that accommodate guests in comfort. A 28-foot tender is available for shore and eco adventure excursions.

With over 700 islands and 2,000 cays, the Bahamas is known for having one of the most diverse diving environments in the world. Clear turquoise waters can plunge to over 6,000-feet deep in places, divers can explore pristine dive sites - reefs, wrecks, walls and more. 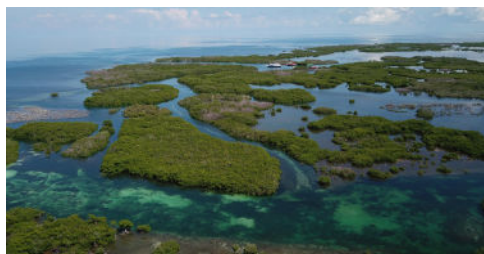
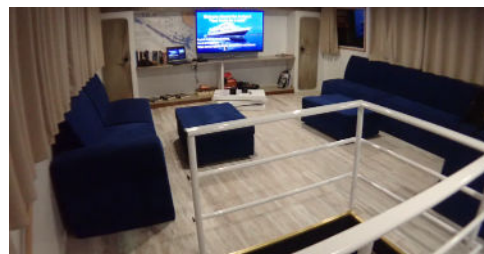
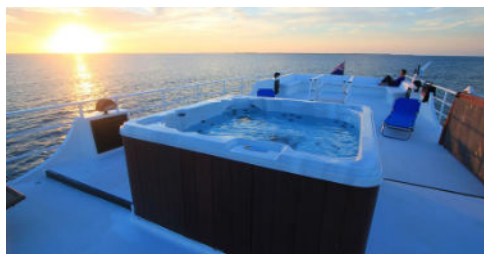


Diving in Cuba is now within reach for U.S. citizens thanks to the Blue Sanctuary educational and conservation workshop program. All Star Cuba is offering up to 4 dives per day in the Jardines de la Reina National Marine Park (Gardens of the Queen). The park is home to 80-plus dive sites including healthy reefs, walls, tunnels, coral caves and caverns, giant ledges, macro-critters, 6 species of sharks and an abundance of fish species.

All Star Liveaboards offers a 7-night experience with up to 22 dives including 2 night dives. Trips showcase the park's

unique ecosystem ranging from coral reefs and mangrove nurseries to vast wetlands, a migratory stop for 68 species of birds, plus snorkeling with crocodiles.

All Star Cuba has partnered with Avalon Diving to offer a luxury scuba diving liveaboard experience with a fleet of vessels traveling to Jardines de la Reina. All cabins include individually climate controlled AC, private bathroom and a TV. Cuban and international cuisine are highlighted. Diving is conducted from 30 ft. (9m) power boats that serve as tenders and transportation for eco excursions.

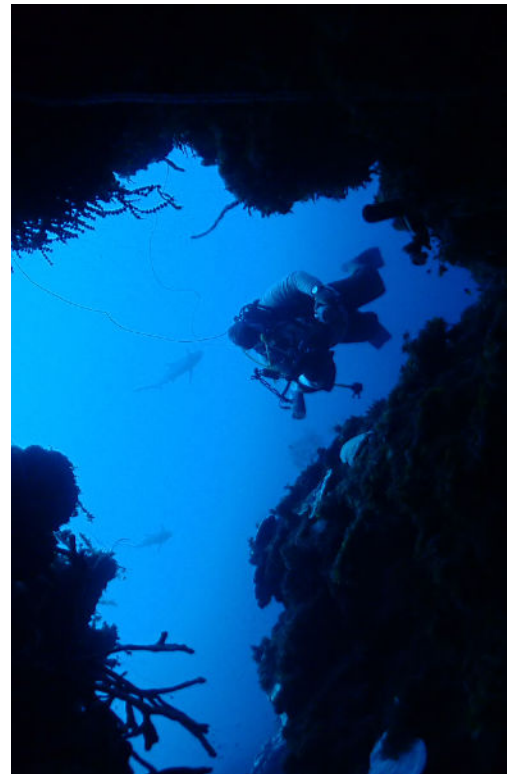
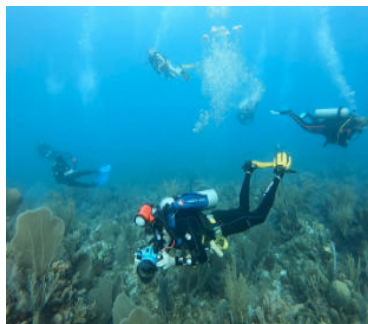

The Red Sea is considered one of the world's best dive destinations. It is home to over 1,000 fish species, vibrant soft corals, unique topographies, world-class wreck diving and sharks. Dive regions include the **Central Red Sea**, home to **Brothers Islands, Daedalus**, and **Elphinstone**, and close encounters with oceanic whitetips and hammerhead sharks. 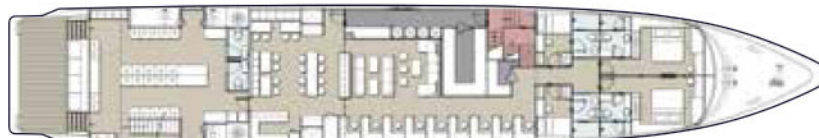
ROOFTOP PLAN

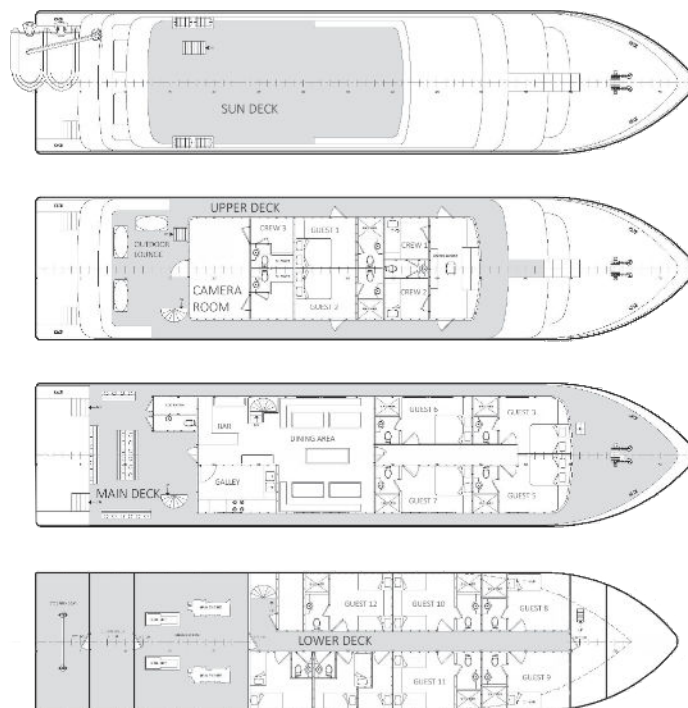

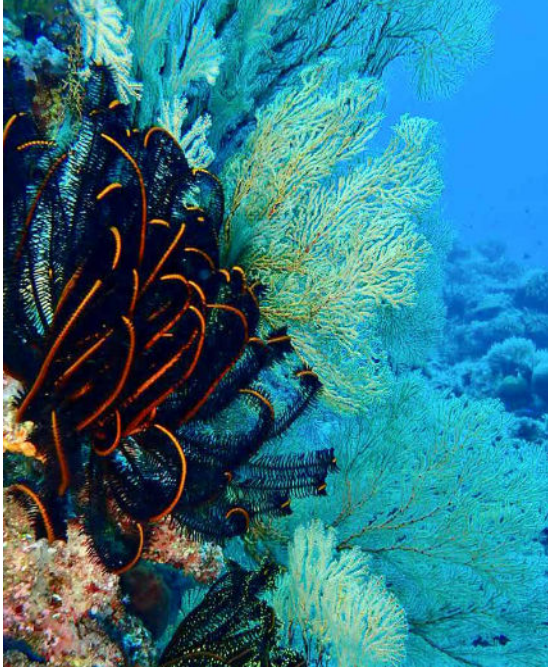

This itinerary boards in Puerto Princesa for 6-night excursions which operate from mid-March to June. Tubbataha Reefs National Park was established as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1993 and is located in the middle of the Sulu Sea, more than 80 miles offshore from Palawan. Accessible only by dive liveaboard, this protected area of extreme biodiversity is reserved to nurture future generations. Tubbataha is comprised of three atolls (North Atoll, South Atoll and Jessie Beazley) that break the surface of the sea by only a few inches. It is home to over 350 coral species, 600 species of fish and 100 bird species. Whale sharks, hammerheads, tiger sharks and manta rays can all be found in the deep cerulean blue waters surrounding these three extraordinary atolls. This itinerary will include up to 19 dives and is tailored for experienced open water or advanced open water divers.

Malapascua is renowned for Monad Shoals dive site where guests can often site thresher sharks and/or manta rays because it serves as a cleaning station. In Leyte, Panaon Island and Sogod Bay offer exceptional opportunities for viewing whale sharks, manta rays and a variety of other species of whales, as well as dolphins.

The Visayas and Bohol itinerary travels south to Cabilao Island known for its steep coral reefs and wall diving, then on Pamalican Island and Balicasag Isle with its sardine balls and large numbers of turtles and rays, before arriving at Apo Island reputed to be one of the best coral reef dives. Apo Island Marine Reserve showcases an abundance of sea turtles, clownfish, schooling barracuda, whitetip sharks and coral gardens.
