Number of Dives: Usually 14-16 (2-3 per day); More possible with full charter

Difficulty Level: Suitable for all skill levels!

First Dive: Sunday afternoon/evening (shallow, easy refresher dive)

Last Dive: Friday late morning (so you can fly out after disembarking on Saturday)

After boarding in Road Town, Cuan Law visits shallow wrecks and reefs around Tortola, Virgin Gorda, Norman Island, Salt Island, and more. Shore excursions are another huge part of a Cuan Law trip, so get ready for bar-hopping, hiking, and water toys when you're not diving.

BOARDING

Cuan Law begins boarding at 12:00pm on Sunday. **Your flight needs to arrive in Tortola or St. Thomas on Saturday.**

It is impossible to fly in on Sunday in time to board Cuan Law. We recommend flying directly into Tortola to avoid problems during travel.

Our driver will be waiting at the ferry dock/airport to take you to the boarding location. A dinghy is sent from Cuan Law to pick passengers up from shore.

ECO-ADVENTURES & EXCURSIONS

Cuan Law is not your typical dive liveaboard. **There are daily opportunities for non-diving adventures!**

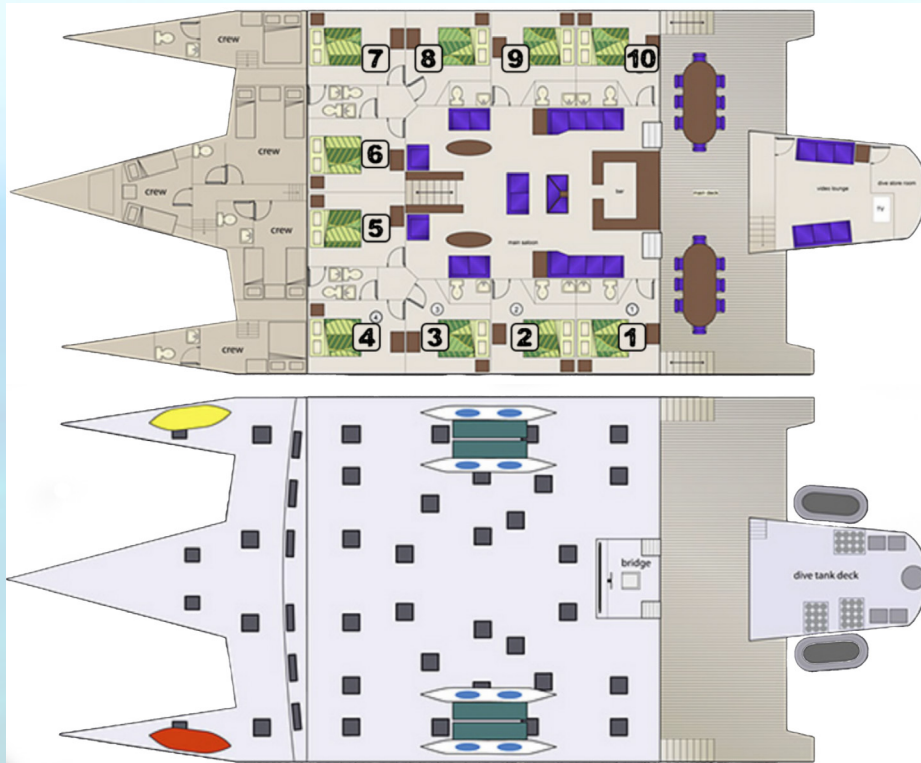
On a standard All Star Cuan Law trip, passengers should expect 2-3 dives per day plus excursions when possible. **On full charters, the itinerary is flexible!** You can do as many or few excursions as conditions allow.

TRAVELING TO THE BVI

We highly recommend flying directly into Tortola (EIS). The MIA>EIS direct flight is the simplest and most risk-free way to travel to the BVI. The next best option is a flying to San Juan, Puerto Rico, then booking a separate ticket from San Juan to Tortola.

Some travelers choose to fly into St. Thomas, USVI, then take a ferry over to Tortola. This is perfectly acceptable, but the possibility of a delay in travel is higher. Ferry tickets should be purchased at least a month prior to departure. Transfers are not included. Our driver will be waiting at the airport or ferry dock based on the arrival information provided on your trip application. Fares range from \$10-\$30/person.

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WHAT TO PACK

A suggested checklist of what to bring can be viewed [here](#). The British Virgin Islands offer many opportunities to go ashore and explore. For these occasions, we highly recommend proper footwear for the eco-adventures. Flip flops are not suitable. We suggest water shoes or TEVA type sandals. Sneakers are fine, but they might get wet!

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CANCELLATION POLICY

No refunds or rebook credits are offered unless the trip departs full. A cancellation fee of 5% will be incurred for any refunds.

If a named storm affects your trip between June 1st and November 30th, we will issue a credit with no expiration date for future travel based on missed dives, but there will be no refund.
