### DIVING INFO

**Certification Requirements:** Advanced Open Water certification and/or 50 logged dives are recommended. Diving accident insurance is also recommended.

**Number of Dives:** Up to 4 per day (3 day dives + 1 night dive), weather permitting.

**Difficulty Level:** Difficulty varies by itinerary and weather conditions, but divers should be prepared for currents and deeper dives. It is also important that divers are able to deploy a DSMB just in case they need to surface alone.

**First Dive:** Shortly after boarding if time permits. If passengers arrive late, or if conditions are not favorable, the first dive will take place on the following morning.

**Last Dive:** Late morning on the day before disembarking. This 24-hour surface time allows passengers to fly out after disembarking on the following day.

### INDONESIA TRAVEL INFORMATION

**VISA:** All travelers to Indonesia must purchase a visa to enter the country. The price is \$35 cash (USD is accepted) or 500K IDR. When you arrive in Jakarta or Bali, you'll be guided to the kiosk before immigration to pay for your visa. We do NOT recommend purchasing your visa online.

### FAQS

- Is nitrox available?.....Yes! It is included in the trip cost (don't forget your nitrox cert card).
- Are drinks included?.....Coffee, tea, juices, and sodas are included in the price of your trip. Beer, wine, and cocktails are available for purchase onboard, or you can BYOB.
- How many dives will I do per day?.....3 dives per day plus night dives when possible.
- Are shore excursions offered?.....Yes, depending on itinerary and if conditions allow it.
- Is any special dive equipment required?.....Yes, all divers need a dive light and DSMB.
- Is dive insurance required?.....Yes, read the Dive/Trip Insurance section below for details.



## PRE-TRIP INFO

### GROUND TRANSFERS & BOARDING / DISEMBARKING

**Ground transfers between the vessel and local airport/hotel on boarding/disembarking day are included in the price of your trip.** Transfers are based on the information on your trip application, so be sure to list the correct flight or local hotel information when you fill it out. We recommend arriving in Indonesia at least a day early to avoid problems due to delays in travel. **If you're staying at a hotel (in the city where the boat boards) prior to the trip, your pick-up time is scheduled for approximately 9am on the day of boarding.**

**Boarding time varies depending on departure location and when passengers arrive at the boat. You will disembark by 10am on the final day of your trip.** After vacating your cabin, you may remain onboard until 3pm to await your departure flight.

### DIVING

The Advanced Open Water certification and at least 50 logged dives are suggested for all divers in Indonesia. An SMB is also necessary for all divers, and a reef hook is recommended.

### DIVE/TRIP INSURANCE

**It is strongly recommended for all passengers to purchase trip insurance to protect you in case of cancelation, interruption, weather delays, or other unforeseen circumstances.** It is also recommended for all divers to have dive accident insurance. We suggest:
