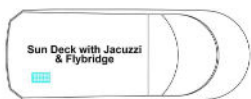

# Egypt

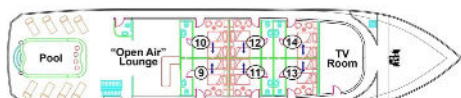
